NEW FOR 2024 - ASSOCIATION LADDER PLAY

For those not familiar with a ladder, it is very simple. Players are ranked according to their ability. Any player can challenge a player up to 3 positions higher than they are on the list. If they play and are successful, they are then placed above the challenged player in the ranking. If the challenger loses nothing changes. A declined challenge is treated as a win for the challenger. The ladder will be run throughout the year. There is no minimum or maximum requirement to make challenges.

The game to be played is a shortened version of the Association game where, after a player makes hoop 1, the clip for the other colour of ball is placed on hoop 4 back, that is, make hoop one with red, place yellow clip on 4 back at the end of your turn. For this year rankings will be based upon historical data or best guess. The intent is to update results weekly and post every Sunday.

All active members will be listed on the initial ranking. If you do not wish to participate simply email jdlegate@outlook.com or place an X beside your name on the posted listing.

PROTOCOLS FOR BLOCK PLAY 2024

*** IN HONOUR OF OUR 50TH ANNIVERSARY AT EVERY TOURNAMENT GAME DURING THIS YEAR, WEAR SOMETHING RED, BLUE, BLACK OR YELLOW AS A TOP OR BOTTOM ***

Block play is multi-week 'league' play in different formats. The number of blocks (usually 1-3) and number of games per round depends on the number of players that register. Signing up for block play is a commitment to play the first round between **June 1 and July 7** and the second round between **July 12 and August 21**. (The dates schedule is subject to change.) Final day to register for block play is **May 27**.

All players play in the first round and then are sorted for the second round into Championship Flight and A/B Flights based on each players win-loss record. Semi-finals are held on **August 22 and 23**. While semi-final games can be played before or after the scheduled dates, finals for all blocks are held on **August 31 and September 1** only. (The schedule is subject to change.)

The number of wins determines finishing standings in block play. If there is a tie, it will be resolved by number of wins, then head-tohead, then net hoops, then closest to the peg.

Games are arranged between players. Players are equally responsible to complete games by the scheduled dates. Scores are kept by players on sheets posted in the Clubhouse. Scores for the Bayfield Cup must include the date the game is played for submission to the World Croquet Ranking database.

Please see the BICC website for the document "Etiquette Guidelines for Block Play Tournaments" to resolve issues with the scheduling of games.
